champagne pol roger reserve, france

*there are notes of stone fruits, a certain nuttiness and a hint of honey supporting the freshness of the acidity
(optional additional course, £15 supplement)*

franciacorta brut corteauran nv, italy

*biscuity, ripe fruit nose with citrus and yellow plum notes. on the palate the wine is generous with plenty of ripe fruit,
touch creamy, waft of fresh bread, then a lovely mouth-watering acidity giving excellent length and balance*

chateau courac (viognier, roussanne, marsanne, grenache) côtes du rhône 2021

*tropical aromas and tinned peaches spring to mind and bring a real sense of summer with fresh white flowers and
spicy notes*

domaine rolly gassmann (riesling) alsace, france 2019

*the palate is concentrated and complex, with fresh stone fruit characters and a touch of saline on the finish
(optional additional course, £8 supplement)*

akriotou, old vines (savatiano) boeotia, greece 2020

*this offers a complex and aromatic bouquet of ripe peach, quince, creamy vanilla and an intriguing hint of turkish
delight. dry with perfectly balanced freshness, intense notes of grapefruit, pepper, ginger and wild mint lead to a long
and spicy finish*

il seggio bolgheri rosso (cabernet sauvignon, cabernet franc, merlot) italy 2020

*this wine is intense ruby red in colour with aromas of fresh red berries and dark fruit nuances enriched with mineral
and spicy layers. the red fruit characters follows onto the complex palate that combines elegant silky tannins and a
lively clean finish*

tokaji late harvest (furmint) hungary 2020

the wine is intensely aromatic, with notes of honey, apricots, and peach

rutherglen muscat, pfeiffer (muscat) victoria, australia

aromas of rich, raisined fruit greet the nose. the palate is one of luscious fruit, with a lovely long finish
